

CRAFT CORRAL:







With this craft we are making a cowgirl's best friend-- a horse!
This horse is perfect indoor companion for lassoing up varmints, galloping through the fields, and going on your next big adventure. The relationships between cowgirls and horses are special, and now you can have one of your very own.

MATERIALS:

- Two toilet paper rolls
- Yarn
- Tissue Paper or magazine clippings
- Glue & paintbrush
- Hole punch
- Beads, straws, or other decorative items.
- Tape



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut one of the toilet paper rolls in half- this will be the head.



2. Paint glue onto the toilet paper roll and collage on tissue paper, or whatever you have available. Let dry completely.



3. Once dry, punch two holes on each end of the toilet paper roll. Cut approximately two feet of yarn. Pull one end through one hole, through the roll, and out the other hole.



4. On one of the ends of the yarn, put either beads or a paper straw for the neck.




5. Punch two holes through the top and bottom of the half toilet paper roll. Pull the yarn through and over the beads to make a head.



6. For legs, punch four holes, two on each side. Cutting two pieces of string, add beads or straws and tie to secure. Add any extra details, such as a tail!



7. Glue or tape together two popsicle sticks to make an X. Attach the two yarn ends to either side.
