

CRAFT CORRAL:



Horse Finger Puppets





Put on your very own Wild West show or cowgirl ropin' roundup with this horse finger puppet! Make one horse for a daring adventure or make a team for a rodeo challenge. The choice is up to you, but this craft is the first step! Your horse companion will be there every step of the way.

MATERIALS

- Cardstock or heavy scrapbook paper
- Glue
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Pen or Pencil
- Yarn
- Googly Eye



HORSE FINGER PUPPET

1. Cut out a body, a neck, and a head out of scrapbook paper. Use a pen or pencil to sketch the shapes if needed. Glue together.



2. Once the glue has dried, punch a hole for a tail. Tie 2-3 strings of yarn and tie a knot.



3. Punch holes down the neck and the top of the head. Tie yarn to make a mane. Glue down one googly eye and attach a small triangle for an ear.



4. Punch four holes at the bottom of the horse's torso.



5. Place your fingers through the holes, and your horse is ready to gallop! Feel free to decorate your horse however you choose, and tag us @cowgirlmuseum
